### Abstracts

Abstracts must be written using Microsoft Word or other translatable format and submitted electronically via e-mail to [mjchen@saas.sh.cn](mailto:mjchen@saas.sh.cn), or [m62200747@163.com](mailto:m62200747@163.com). Since no editing will be undertaken, author(s) are requested to prepare the abstract carefully. Abstracts and abstract titles should not exceed 1500 and 150

characters, respectively (including spaces). The title should be typed in capital letters and bold type-face. Leave one blank line and follow with the authors' names (initials first) and the full address of the institution (s) where the work was done, underlining the presenting author in cases of co-authored papers. Leave one blank line and follow with the abstract text using fully justified margins and no paragraph breaks. Use single-space typing in 11-point "Times" or "Times New Roman" font throughout. Do not include references and use only common abbreviations.

#### **PASSPORT, VISA REQUIREMENTS, TRAVEL INSURANCE**

All visitors to China must hold valid passports and a Chinese visa. Participants are responsible for obtaining the necessary visas to enter China, and for the purchase of insurance that may be necessary in respect of any personal loss, injury or damage associated with attendance at the meeting. Free health care is not available to non-residents of China and participants are strongly advised to arrange travel and health insurance prior to departure.

The weather in Shanghai in October usually warm and pleasant with daytime temperatures of 20-25°C, dropping to 10-15°C at night. Lightweight clothing such as short sleeves and cotton dresses are recommended for the daytime but a light jacket or sweater is desirable at night.

#### **PUDONG AND HONGQIAO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORTS**

Shanghai is served by two international airports, Pudong and Hongqiao. Most international flights and some domestic flights use Pudong International Airport that is located 40 km from the Guhua Garden Hotel Shanghai. Taxi fee from Pudong Airport to Guhua Garden Hotel Shanghai is about 200 Yuan and will take about one hour without traffic jams. Some domestic flights arrive at Hongqiao Airport which is located in the west of Shanghai, 36 km from the Guhua Garden Hotel Shanghai. Taxi fee from Hongqiao Airport to the Guhua Garden Hotel is about 150 Yuan and will take about one hour without traffic jams.
